



Soccer Academy 2024/25 Application Letter

Dear Parents or Guardians,

The Abbotsford School District Soccer Academy program at Abbotsford Senior Secondary School is a paid program offered to students with an elite level of soccer skill and display a passion for soccer. The Soccer Academy's goal is to present a competitive, highly skilled environment for students with an elite level of soccer. The Soccer Academy will work on developing soccer skills, soccer intelligence, game play and athletic development with the goal of preparing students with the soccer ability to play at the next level beyond high school. The Soccer Academy has hired the services of three highly respected soccer coaches from the university level to provide the instruction for soccer classes. Rob Giesbrecht, president of the women's soccer team at Trinity Western University and HPL coach, Mike Shearon, the head coach of the men's soccer team at Trinity Western University, and Allan Alderson, former professional player, and coach. Brent Ciochetti is the teacher coordinating the academy as well as providing the instruction for the Physical Education and Fitness and Conditioning portion of the soccer academy classes. In addition to the classes, the Academy will play 3 to 4 games against other academies from the Lower Mainland. First semester male students will have the opportunity to tryout for the senior boy's school soccer team, that plays games twice weekly, with additional practices from September to the end of November.

The Soccer Academy will receive instruction from our three hired coaches twice a week on Mondays and Wednesdays, from September through June, working on elevating student's soccer skills and game play. The remainder of the classes on Tuesdays, Thursdays, and Fridays, will be used to cover the required curriculum for Fitness and Conditioning and Physical Education 9-12, using soccer as the primary vehicle for instruction. At the end of the school year, students will receive credit for two classes, provided they have met the learning outcomes: one course credit for Physical Education 9,10,11, or 12 and one course credit for Fitness and Conditioning 9, 10, 11, or 12. In addition to the soccer instruction, all students will receive a kit that includes pinnie, shorts, shirt, and a hoodie.

The fees for the Soccer Academy are proposed to be \$900 for the year. These fees cover the costs for a soccer kit, soccer instructors, equipment, and Academy travel games expenses and uniforms. Once accepted into the academy, a non-refundable deposit of \$200 will be put on **Cash Online** for payment. Approved applicants will be notified by April 19, 2024, and the deposit must be paid by May 15, 2024. Failure to pay the deposit will allow the next student on the waiting list to take the spot.

Priority for acceptance into the Soccer Academy will be based on the level of soccer played.

Reminder:

- 1) An application must be submitted by every student (New and renewal).
- 2) Every application must have a parent signature. (New and renewal).
- 3) Every application must be handed in and time stamped by the registrar (Mrs. Glenn).

IMPORTANT DATES:

February 1st, 2024 – registration for soccer academy opens. New students please submit the School Application form with supporting documents, the Soccer Application, and the Student Expectations form. For out of catchment applications, be sure to include the Non-Catchment form **signed by the catchment principal**.

March 15, 2024 – registration for soccer academy closes. Applications for entry into the program following this date will only be accepted based on available spots left in the academy.

April 19, 2024 – Applicants will be notified as to whether their application has been approved, denied, or deferred to a waitlist. If approved, applicants will be required to submit a non-refundable \$200 deposit. This will be via School Cash On-line.

May 15, 2024 – Deadline for successful applicants to submit the Soccer Academy payment form and pay the non-refundable \$200 deposit to the school or School Board Office.

September 11, 2024 – Applicants with a deferred status are reviewed pending space in the academy. Deferred applicants will be notified as to the status of their application. After this date, admission to the academy is closed if all available spots have been filled.
