City: 140, 000 people / 1 hour drive from Vancouver / one of fastest growing cities in Canada / close to border with USA / Moderate climate / Surrounded by mountains and nature

British Columbia Education is recognized by PISA as being one of the top performing education systems in the world. As part of the BC Education system Abbotsford schools deliver world class education.

31 Elementary Schools (Kinder – Grade 5) / 8 Middle Schools (Grades 6 – 8) /
7 High Schools (Grades 9 – 12)

International Students: Study options of 1 Semester (5 months) / Academic Year (10 Months) / Multiple years / Graduation

Students are fully integrated into classes with Canadian Students. English Language Support is available at all schools and provided as required.

No scholarships for entering high school but high achieving International Students can and do receive University Entrance Scholarships.

Orientation: Occurs each semester the week before school begins. Language / math testing, program and homestay expectations, school introduction, course counselling.

Student Support: 9 Fulltime multi-lingual International Assistants (IA's) work with students to provide help with anything that students need. IA's monitor academic progress, help with social issues, activities, homestay... Students can contact IA's in their offices, by phone, text...

Homestay: We provide our own quality homestay program. Families have maximum 2 students / English only policy. Option to work with private providers.

Activities and Events: Each semester International Students visit Vancouver, Victoria and go skiing at Whistler. Throughout the year international Students participate in outdoor activities with local students such as whitewater rafting, camping, snow shoeing, paintball, climbing...

All of our schools are on the semester system.

Each academic year (10 months) has 2 semesters (5 months/semester). Students study and complete 4 different courses each semester. As an example, a student might choose the following schedule...

Semester 1: September to January

Pre-Calculus 11, Chemistry 11, Composition 11, TV and Film 11

Semester 2: February to June

Life Sciences (Biology) 11, Ceramics and Sculpture 11, Intercultural Studies (Socials)

11 and Animation 11

At the end of the year the student will have completed 8 different courses.





Abbotsford School of Integrated Arts integrates the arts into all aspects of curiculum, including academic courses. This program provides students with direct intensive study and skill development in the Fine Arts, and opportunities to demonstrate their learning in all subjects through the Arts. Each classroom teacher is required to have post-secondary qualifications or equivalent experience and/or training in music, art, dance, digital media, or drama, as well as specializations in core academic subjects. This school has limited space and specific application requirements. Students must submit a portfolio of previous work to demonstrate their commitment to the arts, and complete an interview with school administration prior to acceptance.

Abbotsford Traditional Secondary School is a public school of choice within the Abbotsford School District. ATSS provides traditional values, a crested dress code, and a One-to-One Notebook Computer Program for each students education. Academic studies include Advanced Placement, Fine and Performing Arts classes, Applied Skills classes, Science and Math classes, Language and Humanities classes, and an Athletics program that provide a quality, balanced education for students.

Before applying to ATSS it is necessary to contact our office first to discuss if the school will be a good fit for the student. Most years space is limited, so it is also important that we confirm that attendance will be possible.
