School-Based Student Orientation	
All students are also required to attend a school-based orientation. It will take place at the student's school on January 30, 2023.	
The first official first day of school will be February 1, 2023.	

<u>Early Arrivals</u>: Most of you will arrive in Canada a few days before orientation. If you arrive before the centralized orientation, DO NOT report to your school. The first day of orientation is the first time we need to see you.

**Late Arrivals**: If you plan on arriving <u>after January 27, 2023</u>, you will need to contact the International Student Department. You will need to bring your passport and Study Permit/or Visa to the appointment.
