Important Information

Please read the following as there is important information you must know about the Orientation you will attend before starting school. All students are expected to attend the Orientation so please make your travel arrangements accordingly.

Centralized Student Orientation

When: January 22, 23, and 24, 2018

Time: 9am – 3pm Please arrive on time.

Location: To be announced

Please ensure to bring the following items to the centralized orientation:

- Passport and Student Permit (Visa)
- A packed lunch (for all 3 days), a pencil, pen, and eraser

Students are required to attend all three days of the centralized orientation.

School-Based Student Orientation

All students are also required to attend a school-based orientation. It will take place at the student's school, Secondary Level on January 25 or 26, 2018 and Elementary level on Jan 30 or 31. The students will be informed of the date at the orientation.

The first official day of school for Secondary Students will be January 29, 2018.

The first official day of school for Elementary and Middle students will be February 1, 2018.

Early Arrivals: Most of you will arrive in Canada a few days before orientation. **If you arrive before orientation, DO NOT report to your school.** The first day of orientation is the first time we need to see you.

Late Arrivals: If you arrive **after January 24, 2018**, you will need to report to the International Student Department.
