NOTE: The Abbotsford School District MUST be informed in writing of student's arrival date in Canada. The Abbotsford School District will only provide medical coverage up to 2 weeks prior to orientation. If a student arrives before this date, they must arrange their own travel insurance.

For students completing their studies in June, the District will cease the medical coverage as of June 30.
For students completing their studies in January, the District will cease the medical coverage as of January 31.

Any medical conditions, prescribed medications, learning issues, and social and/or behavioral issues must be reported below. If not, this may lead to a cancellation and/or a dismissal from the program without any refund.

All students start their medical insurance on private medical insurance coverage.
One semester student stays on private medical insurance for the semester.
Two semester student, with separate paper study permits, maybe eligible for Provincial Medical Services Plan (MSP).

Please note, the private medical insurance does **not** cover any pre-existing conditions.

Misrepresentation or Nondisclosure of pre-existing conditions, results in students not having full medical insurance coverage and the possibility of financial liability for medical treatment.

After submitting the application, if a student is diagnosed with an illness and is prescribed medication that will continue after the student arrives in Abbotsford, it is your responsibility to report to the International Program.

For students completing their studies in June, district homestay arrangement will cease on or before June 30.

For students completing their studies in January, district homestay arrangement will cease on or before January 31.

(Effective date: July 1, 2018) Students in the District Homestay are charged for full month of homestay fee from September to June. The only partial month adjustments will be made for the orientation period in August or January.

The District International Program won't be able to place students that are taking prescribed medications in the District homestay program. Therefore, students taking prescribe medications must make their own homestay arrangement. If a student is placed in a District homestay and does not report his/her condition, this may lead to a cancellation of the District homestay placement.
