


Outdoor Adventures

ACTIVITIES OFFERED

Throughout the year we offer a variety of activities after school and on weekends.

- Skills night learn how to camp
- Camping, Whitewater River Rafting and Kayaking on the Chilliwack River
- Camping and hiking up Black Tusk in beautiful Garibaldi Park
- Paintball after school
- Snowshoeing / Tubing
- Multiple Skiing / Snowboarding trips to Sasquatch Mountain Resort - some are overnight
- Cross Country Skiing at Sasquatch Resort
- Hiking and camping in the spectacular Stein Valley
- Paddle boarding at Cultus lake
- Mountain Biking on Sumas Mountain
