



# **INTERNATIONAL BACCALAUREATE (IB)**

The IB program provides high school students the chance to complete 1st year university-level coursework while still in high school. The 2 year Diploma Programme is offered in grades 11 and 12 at Abbotsford Secondary, a fully accredited IB World School. In addition to providing leadership and global citizenship experiences, the IB programme is recognized internationally for its academic rigour. IB programme graduates who score well in IB subjects may receive university credit and / or scholarships for their efforts, and tend to obtain significantly higher GPA's in the first year university.
