## PACKAGE PRICES INCLUDE

Homestay placement, airport pickup and drop off, custodianship (notarized document) and mentor program, host family pay (meals and accommodation) and orientation. **Packages are based on a Sept. 1 or Feb 1 arrival date but invoices are issued from Aug 15 or Jan 15 to provide flexibility in arranging for flights as most students arrive before those dates.** Invoices can be adjusted to a daily rate with a submission of ticketed flights. Please do not make full payment prior to the invoices being amended. We will not issue refunds once the invoices have been paid in full. Custodian documents are provided with payment of the non-refundable down payment of \$100 per student.

## ADDITIONAL FEES

**Package prices cover five or ten exact months of homestay.** Additional days are \$50 per day.

Canadian meals may vary but for students who wish to have vegan, vegetarian, or gluten free meal options there is an additional fee. Unless medically necessary, special diets cannot be introduced or adjusted once a student has begun their study abroad program. Special meal fees are \$750 per semester.

Wire transfer payments will be charged a \$50 wire transfer bank fee.

## HOMESTAY PLACEMENT

We place students with host families for a Canadian cultural experience and to improve their English Language skills. Our student application form gives us details about the student so we can match them with a great family that has similar interests. Our families are thoroughly vetted prior to placement.

## HOST FAMILY PAY

The monthly pay includes accommodation, three meals per day, and a welcoming, loving environment.

Transportation is not included in this rate. Every student has their own private bedroom (private bathrooms are not guaranteed but sometimes an option). Unlimited WiFi is provided at no extra cost.

## CUSTODIANSHIP

Our custodianship is the heart of our program. Every student is treated as an individual and assigned a mentor who checks in on the student a minimum of every two weeks. We are there to help the student transition to Canadian life and face any challenges as they arise. Custodianship students attend an orientation after their arrival. There will be optional activities offered throughout the year for varying costs.

## AIRPORT SERVICES

Initial airport pickup and final departure drop off is provided by host families or a pickup service if host families are not available. Arrivals and departures are recommended to be booked for the weekend to allow host families to pick up or drop off. This service must be booked a minimum of 48 hours in advance and is not refundable. If a student is traveling during their stay they need to arrange those airport transfers themselves by transit, Uber, taxi or another airport service company.
