School Activities

Throughout the year there are SO MANY ways to participate! Theme days, PEP rallies, performances, competitions, musical theatre, clubs, field trips, cheering on sports teams... There are Outdoor Adventures organized by the schools such as paintball, rafting, canyoning, camping, climbing, skiing/snowboarding, mountain biking. We encourage students to get involved with Volunteering or with the Leadership Class, they are always getting together to plan, organize and execute events like Halloween, Carnival days, theme days....



Community facilities / events

Outside of school hours there are:

Board Game Cafes, Escape Rooms, a Virtual Reality Game Centre, a MultiPlex movie theatre, 2 shopping malls, an old style "downtown" with lots of cafe's, bakeries, boutiques, a large park with a lake in the city centre where you can fish, more fishing locations nearby where you can rent equipment, MANY kilometers of hiking / riding trails, music festivals, Tulip Festival, art galleries, food trucks, spas, salons, professional sports, GoKarts, Mini-golf, Amusement Centre... There are seasonal events like Halloween, Pumpkin

Patches, Easter, SunFlower fields, Christmas Events in the city centre, concerts, yoga with goats, open air movie nights... Nearby there are ski hills, waterslides, highrope adventures, horseback riding, tandem parachuting, a waterski lake...There are lots of restaurants, coffeeshops and bakeries.
