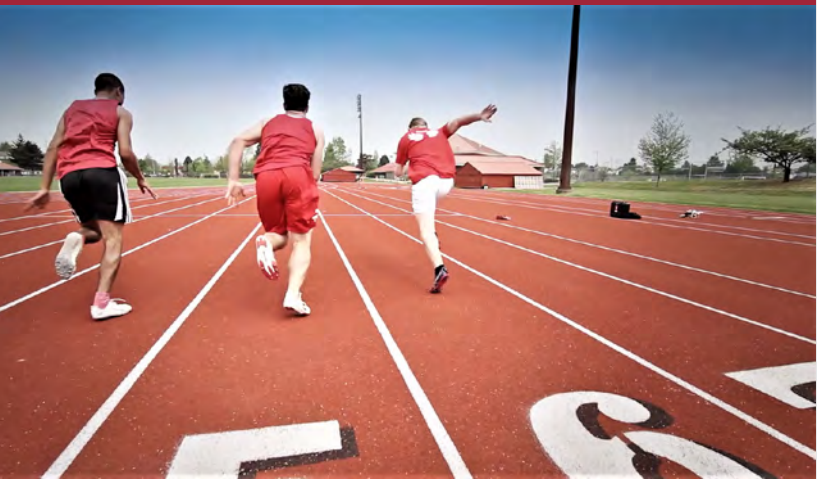

Students take 4 courses per semester.

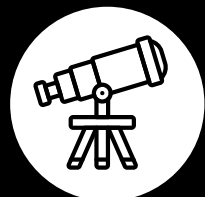
Total annual = 8 courses.

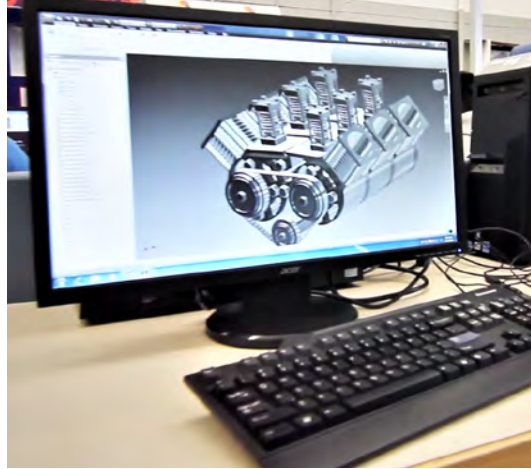
